Suspension: Academic Progress & Planning

1. Who should I contact about my course planning?

Suspension: Tuition & Financial Aid

1. I've been suspended for this quarter after it already started, will I be refunded my fees?

Yes. You will receive a 100% refund of your fees.

2. How is my financial aid impacted by my suspension?

All students' financial aid is unique and is often contingent on enrollment. Note that you may be required to repay financial aid that has already been disbursed to you prior to the start of your suspension.
